- We can get help to do what is right? **3rd & 6th**
- Jesus wants us to have a close, personal relationship with God? **Introduction**
- We should pray for the Church to teach the right things about God? **1st**
- We should praise and adore the Lord? **1st**
- We should acknowledge that God is in charge over all things? **Doxology**
- We should thank God always because we have what we really need? **4th**
- We should pray for our government and President? **4th**
- We can be forgiven of our sins? **5th**
- That Christ can defeat everything Satan and sin can do to us? **6th**
- That we should pray for wars to end and peace to come? **3rd**
- That we should pray for help to believe in Jesus and the Bible? **2nd**
- That we should pray to go to heaven when we die? **7th**
- That we can be sure that God hears and answers our petitions in Jesus' name? **Doxology**
- That we should forgive those who hurt us or do wrong to us? **5th**
